DESCRIPTION

This position will be responsible for: (1) Arranging for and convening Child and Family Team meetings, facilitating the process and summarizing the decision making outcome. These structured, facilitated meetings bring family members together so that, with the support of professionals and community resources, they can create a plan that ensures child safety and meets the family's needs. (2) Provide after hours social work services after regular office hours, on weekends and holidays. (3) Conduct home studies as court ordered and/or requested by Intrastate Compact. Complete courtesy interviews and kinship care assessments as requested by other county departments of Social Services.

Four year degree in social work or a closely related human services field and at least three years professional level social work experience.
