Child Protective Services - Adoptions: The primary purpose of this position is to execute the agency's mandate to arrange substitute care appropriate to a child's needs when parents are unable to care for the child(ren), to carry out the agency's Permanency Planning Mandate and to recruit, assess, license and supervise foster and adoptive homes. The position also functions to enhance services to foster and adoptive children/families by assessing qualified and trained families that provide temporary or permanent in-home care. Other responsibilities include foster care and adoption services to infants relinquished at birth, LINKS Coordinator in providing services to children ages 13-21, Interstate Compact Services, adult adoptee searches, adoption and foster care inquiries and voluntary CBA placements in emergency foster homes. Employee performs other duties as assigned. A valid NC drivers' license and access to a passenger vehicle is required. Employees operating their personal vehicles for county business shall maintain the minimum liability coverage required by the state of North Carolina in accordance to the County Fleet Policy and Employee Safety Program (page 10, section G.) Child Welfare social workers must live within range of the beeper. Must be able to lift and carry a child. Position is located in Tarboro; however, office location may change based on the needs of the agency.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

Thorough knowledge of social work principles, techniques and practices and their application to complex casework, group work, and community problems. Considerable knowledge of a wide range of medical, behavioral, and/or psychosocial problems and their treatment theory. Considerable knowledge of family and group dynamics and a range of intervention techniques, governmental and private organizations, and resources in the community, laws, regulations, and policies which govern the program. General knowledge of the methods and principles of casework supervision and training. In certain settings, considerable knowledge of medical terminology, disease processes and their treatment as they relate to decisions regarding clinical interventions and appropriate therapies based on medial or psychological diagnosis. Skill in establishing rapport with a client and in applying techniques or assessing psychosocial, behavioral, and psychological aspects of client's problems. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with members of case load and their families, as well as civic, legal, medical, social, and religious organizations. Ability to express ideas clearly and concisely and to plan and execute work effectively.

Minimum Training and Experience:

Master's degree in social work from an accredited school of social work; Bachelor's degree from an accredited school of social work and completion of the Child Welfare Collaborative (Child Welfare positions only); Bachelor's degree in social work from an accredited school of social work and one year directly related experience; Master's degree in a human services field and one year of directly related experience; Bachelor's degree in a human services field from an accredited college or university and two years of directly related experience; Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university and three years of directly related experience. One year of work experience can be credited for completion of the social work collaborative. Preferences: Prefer applicants with computer experience and/or knowledge of State Network Systems, NC FAST, imaging programs and Windows software including Microsoft Word. Bilingual applicants (English/Spanish) encouraged to apply.

Salary Range: \$35,945.00 (if fully qualified for the position) or possibly higher depending on experience and credentials. Compensation for full-time employees include excellent benefits that total over \$9,000.00 annually.
