Located in the heart of North Carolina's Piedmont, Rowan County is attractively and conveniently nestled between the state's largest city and its Capitol. Rowan County is made up of more than 20 departments and nearly 1,250 employees that are committed to providing a wealth of services to County residents and businesses.

The County is currently accepting applications for the position of **SOCIAL WORKER II**. This position assesses applicants and recipients of the Work First Family Assistance Program (WFFA) and develops a Service Plan in the areas of Job Search, Job Preparation, Job Training, or Worksite Placement; interviews clients and evaluates to determine the scope of the problems; performs assessments to identify needs; obtains medical, financial, and social history; evaluates for subsidized child care assistance; explores alternative community resources and agencies to make referrals to other services; monitors service delivery to clients for Work First Employment Services; refers clients and families to a variety of services to meet financial needs; develops community or service resource information and develops volunteer programs as part of the Employment and Training Program; coordinates with local entities and businesses to arrange for employment and training opportunities for clients; and provides assistance to Social Worker II Lead worker as needed.

Minimum qualifications include a Bachelor's Degree in Social Work; or a Bachelor's Degree in a human service field and one year of social work or counseling experience. If degree is not in Social Work, please submit a copy of college transcript with application. Degree/Coursework must be from an appropriately accredited institution.

Starting Salary \$50,400 - \$55,400/annual (commensurate with experience) and excellent benefits package available. Benefits include health, dental, vision, retirement, 401K, flexible spending, paid holidays, employee discounts, and more.
