Located in the heart of North Carolina's Piedmont, Rowan County is attractively and conveniently nestled between the state's largest city and its Capitol. Rowan County is made up of more than 20 departments and nearly 1,250 employees that are committed to providing a wealth of services to County residents and businesses.

The County is currently accepting applications for the position of **Part-Time SOCIAL WORKER III (Adult Services).** This position is responsible for managing a caseload of persons under the guardianship have a variety of diagnoses, including medical conditions, severe and persistent mental illness, intellectual and developmental disorders, substance use disorders, and a combination of these diagnoses. This position will also receive and evaluate reports of alleged abuse, neglect and/or exploitation of disabled adults and to mobilize protective services in those cases where maltreatment is confirmed and the need for protection is substantiated. Additionally, this position will monitor and conduct complaint investigations of licensed adult care facilities. Hours will not exceed 999 hours per calendar year.

This position requires general knowledge of basic social work principles, techniques and practices and their application to specific casework, group work and community problems; knowledge and understanding of advanced social work investigative and assessment techniques; general knowledge of both governmental and private organizations; general knowledge of resources from within the local community; ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with administrative superiors, with members of the caseload and their family members, and civic, medical, religious and social organizations; ability to express ideas clearly and concisely in written and spoken word, as well as to plan and execute work effectively.

Requires a Master's Degree in Social Work; or a Bachelor's Degree in Social Work and one year of human services work experience in the areas of case management, assessment and referral, supportive counseling, intervention, psycho-social therapy and treatment planning; or a Bachelor's Degree in a human services field and two years of directly related work experience; or an equivalent combination of education and experience. Adult Services experience preferred. MS Office experience is preferred. All degrees/coursework must be from an appropriately accredited institution. **If degree is not in Social Work, please submit a copy of transcript with application.** A valid driver's license is required.
